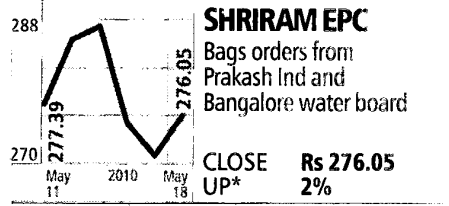

Shriram EPC awarded two energy projects worth Rs 125 cr

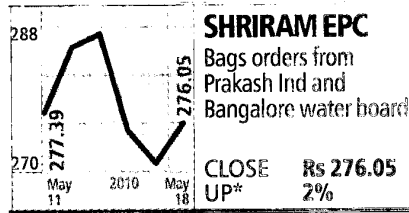
