Shriram Bags ₹488-cr NMDC Order

Chennai: Shriram EPC Limited (SEPC), a leading service provider of integrated design, engineering, procurement, construction and project management services for power plants, renewable energy projects, process and metallurgical plants and municipal service sector projects, has said that it has been awarded the contract for the installation of a byproduct complex, including effluent treatment plant at the 3.0

MTPA steel plant of NMDC at Nagarnar in Chattisgarh. The value of the order is ₹488 crore of which the value for Shriram EPC Ltd is ₹260 crore.

The order entails design, engineering, supply of plant & equipment, structural and civil works, erection, testing and commissioning. The schedule for completion of the project is 30 months.

Shriram EPC will lead a consortium in association with Hutni Projekt of the Czech Republic and Beekay

Engineering Corporation to complete the order.
