Shriram EPC awarded two energy projects worth Rs 125 cr

Chennai: Shriram EPC Limited (SEPC) has been awarded orders amounting to Rs 125 crore. The first order amounting to Rs 49 crore is from Prakash Industries Limited (PIL) to set up a coal handling plant at its Champa power plant in Chhattisgarh. The company has also received orders totaling Rs 76 crore from the Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage Board for providing sewerage systems to the erstwhile KR Puram and Bommanahalli CMC areas. One project is expected to be completed in 24 months and the other is expected to be completed in 36 months. © EN
